The Options Clearing Corporation (OCC) has been informed that DDR Corporation (DDR) will change its name, trading symbol and CUSIP to SITE Centers Corporation (SITC), CUSIP 82981J109 effective October 12, 2018. As a result, futures symbol DDR1D will change to SITC1D effective at the opening of business on October 12, 2018.

All other terms will not change. Clearing Member input to OCC must use the new futures symbol SITC1D commencing October 12, 2018.
