The FIS component of the FIS1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the FIS1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of

fractional FIS shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Futures Contract Adjustment

DATE: Effective the opening of the business day after the merger is consummated. Contract adjustment is anticipated to occur in the third quarter of 2019.

PRICING

Until the cash in lieu of fractional shares is determined, the underlying price for the WP2D Futures contract deliverables, expressed in term of current market value, would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{WP2D} = 0.9287 (\text{FIS}) + 11.00$$

Please note that the valuation would apply only to the WP2D deliverable in terms of current market value of the deliverable securities. The resulting price would not be equivalent to the daily settlement price of a futures contract month, whose determination would include cost of money carrying charges, adjustment for dividends, and other factors.

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The FIS component of the WP2D deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the WP2D deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional FIS shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require delivery of the appropriate cash amount.

BACKGROUND

On July 24, 2019, Shareholders of Worldpay, Inc. (WP) will vote concerning the proposed merger with Fidelity National Informational Services, Inc. (FIS). If the merger is approved and consummated, each existing WP Class A Common Share will be converted into the right to receive 0.9287 FIS Common Shares plus \$11.00 Cash. Cash will be paid in lieu of fractional FIS shares.
