SUBJECT: PRIVATEBANCORP, INC. - CASH IN LIEU SETTLEMENT
ADJUSTED OPTION SYMBOL: CM1

PrivateBancorp, Inc. options were adjusted on June 23, 2017 (See OCC Information Memo #41387). The new deliverable became 1) 41 Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (CM) Common Shares, 2) Cash in lieu of 0.76 fractional CM share, and 3) \$2,720.00 Cash. Only settlement of the cash portion of CM1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$81.859137 per whole CM share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.76 \times \$81.859137 = \$62.21 \text{ per CM1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of June 23, 2017 through July 13, 2017, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Terms of the CM1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract: 1) 41 Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (CM) Common Shares
2) \$2,782.21 Cash (\$2,720.00 + \$62.21)

STRIKE PRICES: Unchanged

CUSIP: CM: 136069101

MULTIPLIER: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

SETTLEMENT

The CM component of CM1 exercise/assignment activity from June 23, 2017 through July 12, 2017, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$2,782.21 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

PRICING

The underlying price for CM1 options will be determined as follows:

$$\text{CM1} = 0.41 (\text{CM}) + 27.8221$$

For example, if CM closes at 84.30, the CM1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{CM1} = 0.41 (84.30) + 27.8221 = 62.39$$
