BACKGROUND

On September 18, 2018, Shareholders of State Bank Financial Corporation (STBZ) will vote concerning the proposed merger with Cadence Bancorporation (CADE). If the merger is approved and consummated, each existing STBZ Common Share will be converted into the right to receive 1.16 CADE Class A Common Shares.
