**SUBJECT: ADJUSTED CAN-FITE BIOPHARMA LTD. – CASH IN LIEU  
SETTLEMENT  
ADJUSTED OPTION SYMBOL: CANF1**

Adjusted Can-Fite BioPharma Ltd. options were adjusted on May 10, 2019 (See OCC Information Memo #44993). The new deliverable became 1) 6 Can-Fite BioPharma Ltd. (CANF) American Depositary Shares, and 2) Cash in lieu of approximately 0.6667 fractional CANF Shares, if any, less any applicable fees and withholdings. Only settlement of the cash portion of CANF1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$4.56 per whole CANF share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.6667 \times \$4.56 = \$3.04 \text{ per CANF1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of May 10, 2019 through May 16, 2019 to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Terms of the CANF1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract: 1) 6 Can-Fite BioPharma Ltd. (CANF) American Depositary Shares  
2) \$3.04 Cash

STRIKE PRICES: Unchanged

CUSIP: CANF: 13471N201

MULTIPLIER: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

### **SETTLEMENT**

The CANF component of CANF1 exercise/assignment activity from May 10, 2019 through May 15, 2019 has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$3.04 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

## **PRICING**

The underlying price for CANF1 options will be determined as follows:

$$\text{CANF1} = 0.06 (\text{CANF}) + 0.0304$$

For example, if CANF closes at 6.20, the CANF1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{CANF1} = 0.06 (6.20) + 0.0304 = 0.40$$
