**SUBJECT: CORPORATE CAPITAL TRUST, INC. – CASH IN LIEU
SETTLEMENT
ADJUSTED OPTION SYMBOL: FSK1

Corporate Capital Trust, Inc. options were adjusted on December 20, 2018 (See OCC Information Memo #44225). The new deliverable became 1) 235 FS KKR Capital Corporation (FSK) Common Shares, 2) Cash in lieu of 0.52 fractional FSK shares, and 3) \$50.60 Cash. Only settlement of the cash portion of FSK1 options exercise/assignment activity was subject to delayed settlement.

OCC has been informed that a price of \$5.8613 per whole FSK share will be used to determine the cash in lieu amount. Accordingly, the cash in lieu amount is:

$$0.52 \times \$5.8613 = \$3.05 \text{ per FSK1 Contract}$$

Now that the exact cash in lieu amount has been determined, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees, during the period of December 19, 2018 through January 11, 2019, to deliver the appropriate cash amount.

Terms of the FSK1 options are as follows:

New Deliverable Per Contract: 1) 235 FS KKR Capital Corporation (FSK) Common Shares
2) \$53.65 Cash (\$50.60 + \$3.05)

STRIKE PRICES: Unchanged

CUSIP: FSK: 302635107

MULTIPLIER: 100 (i.e., a premium of 1.50 yields \$150)

SETTLEMENT

The FSK component of FSK1 exercise/assignment activity from December 19, 2018 through January 10, 2019, has settled through National Security Clearing Corporation (NSCC). The \$53.65 cash amount will be settled by OCC.

PRICING

The underlying price for FSK1 options will be determined as follows:

$$\text{FSK1} = 2.35 (\text{FSK}) + 0.5365$$

For example, if FSK closes at 6.01, the FSK1 price would be calculated as follows:

$$\text{FSK1} = 2.35 (6.01) + 0.5365 = 14.66$$
