The Options Clearing Corporation (“OCC”) has been advised that MasterCard Incorporated (MA) has announced a 10 for 1 stock split. The Ex-distribution Date is January 22, 2014. The Payable Date is January 21, 2014. The Record Date is January 9, 2014.

Pursuant to Article XII, Section 3, of OCC's By-Laws, all MasterCard Incorporated Futures will be adjusted as follows:

CONTRACT ADJUSTMENT

Effective Date: January 22, 2014

Futures Symbols: Unchanged

Number of Contracts: Multiplied by 10

Multiplier: 100 (e.g. 1.00 equals \$100.00)

Settlement Prices: All previous day's settlement prices shall be adjusted by dividing by 10 and rounding to four decimal places.
