The Options Clearing Corporation (“OCC”) has been advised that Cognizant Technology Solutions Corporation (CTSH) has announced a 2 for 1 stock split. The Ex-distribution Date is March 10, 2014. The Payable Date is March 7, 2014. The Record Date is February 21, 2014.

Pursuant to Article XII, Section 3, of OCC's By-Laws, all Cognizant Technology Solutions Corporation Futures will be adjusted as follows:

Settlement Prices: All previous day's settlement prices shall be adjusted by dividing by 2 and rounding to four decimal places.
